

## CAMP IROCK & ABEL'S STORY



United Way of Pickens County has partnered with the School District of Pickens County and the Pickens County YMCA to address summer learning loss and improve 3rd grade reading through **Camp iRock**, a successful summer program for struggling readers in rising 1st – 4th grades. Staffed by teachers, YMCA camp counselors, and Call Me MiSTER inters, Camp iRock provides intensive reading instruction in an enriching summer camp environment.

Abel Bishop attended Camp iRock in the Summer of 2022. His prior school year had been a nightmare consisting of daily meltdowns. He suffered from debilitating anxiety and had recently been diagnosed on the autism spectrum.

When Abel got the invitation to attend Camp iRock, his mom, Melissa was both excited and nervous. Could the intervention that Camp iRock provides be what Abel needed? But how would Abel do in that environment? He was shy & reserved, and his confidence was at rock bottom.

Abel was ecstatic when he received the invitation. "Mom, I HAVE to go!" he told his mom. Although it took him a few days to warm up at camp, Abel began to thrive. His teachers, YMCA counselors, and Call Me MiSTERs knew just what he needed. By the end of camp, Abel's reading scores had improved tremendously and he had a new confidence and zeal to learn.

Abel not only recognizes the difference that Camp iRock has made in his life, but he knows that there were generous sponsors who made that possible.
